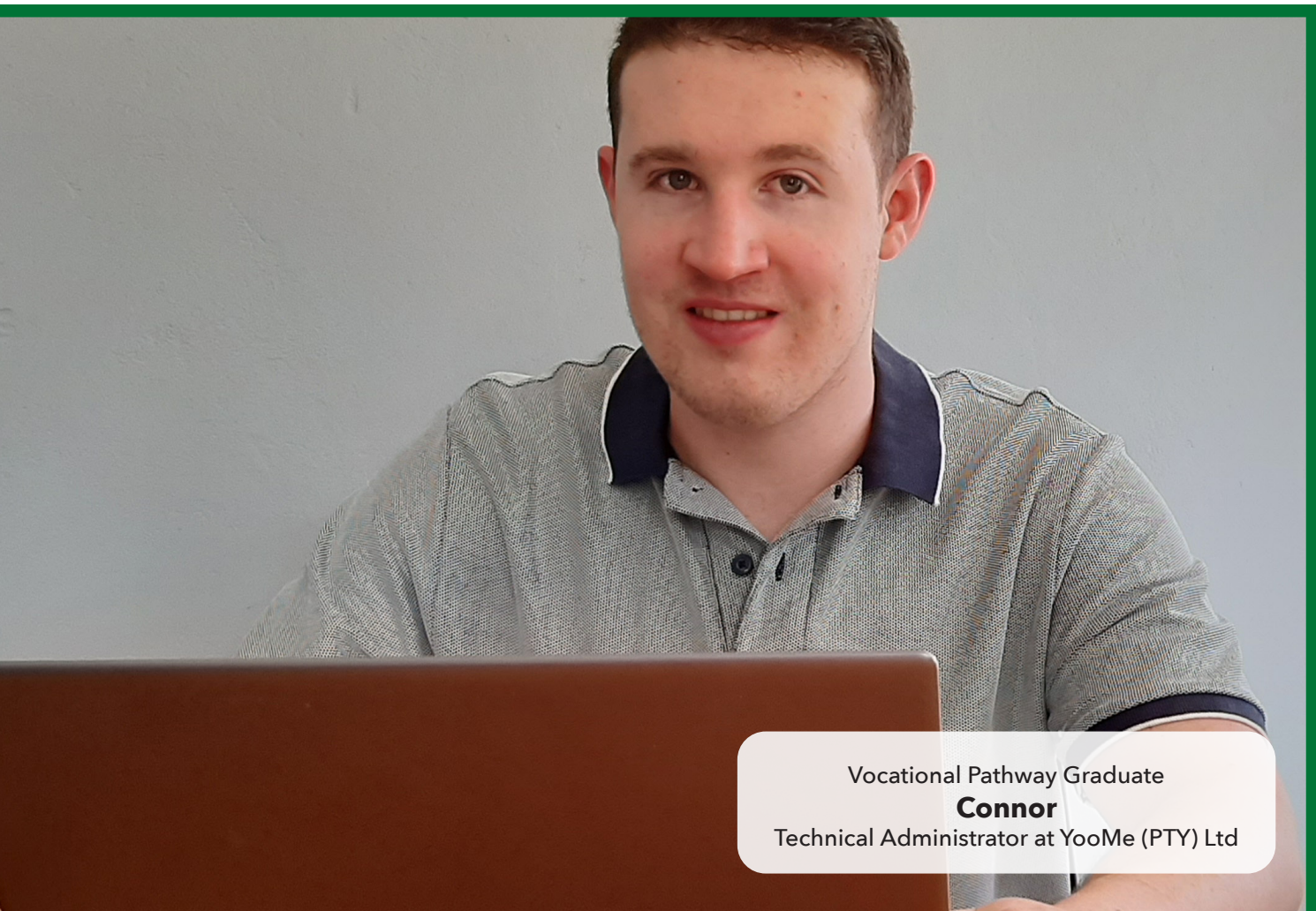

We make learning accessible – with 360° wrap-around support and provision of all reasonable accommodations. We make learning intuitive – with high repetition and content applicable to real life. We are student-centred – everything we do is aimed at ensuring students achieve. The student can progress at their own pace – with flexible timeframes suited to the individual. The BTEC and from IGCSE level, students can choose options of how they want to learn, increasing accessibility and affordability:

- On-Campus In Person (CiP)
- Live Online (LoI) (BTEC and from IGCSE level only)
- A Blend of Both (BoB)

Academic Pathway

The Academic Pathway offers students that are academically-oriented an opportunity to achieve a matric (AS Level Pass). We work within the international education system run by Cambridge University, which is less content-heavy, offers more exam opportunities, alleviating anxiety, and providing the possibility of achieving university entrance. We lobby for necessary concessions and champion our students through their studies and the process of external exams.



Year 4-9 incorporates a blend of the best of both the Cambridge and CAPS curriculum subjects include English, Afrikaans, Mathematics, Science, Geography, History, ICT, EMS, Life Skills and Physical Education.

IGCSE & AS students study English, Afrikaans, Mathematics, Combined Science, Environmental Management, Business Studies and Travel and Tourism through Cambridge Curriculum. Students write the International External Cambridge exams through the British Council.

Vocational Pathway

EDU360 College's Vocational Pathway offers the globally-recognised International BTEC qualification—a unique, career-focussed Pathway designed for students who are ready to step into the future with real-world experience. Developed in collaboration with employers and higher education experts, BTEC bridges the gap between academic learning and industry demands, equipping graduates with essential skills, knowledge, and behaviours that universities and employers highly value. In partnership with Pearson Education, the UK's largest awarding body, and our South African partner, SwitchedOn Education, EDU360 is among the first institutions to bring this forward-thinking qualification to South Africa. We combine Pearson's premier resources with our own commitment to providing exceptional, accessible education, tailored to diverse learning styles. A BTEC is entirely assignment-based, emphasising coursework and practical applications over exams. This flexibility makes it ideal for students who find exams challenging and thrive with project-based learning.

Pivot Pathway

Our Pivot Pathway makes use of a functional approach to introduce subject areas which, when combined with our life skills sessions and therapeutic support, makes learning accessible. We utilise the internationally recognised Award Scheme Development and Accreditation Network (ASDAN), designed for students with a difference between functional and chronological age. This curriculum imparts practical, fundamental skills for life through structured activities providing real evidence of learning. ASDAN turns intangible, hard to observe knowledge and skills into measurable units of ability. Graduating from the Pivot Pathway gives the student a fully accredited ASDAN certificate.
